### **National Curriculum**

As Writers, we will be focusing on saying and building a sentence, using our imagination to create new sentences and we will be focusing on applying capital letters, finger spaces and full stops in our writing. Each day we will practise our letter formation and handwriting.

As Readers we will continue to develop our phonic knowledge by learning new sounds and continue using Fred talk and Fred in our head to support reading, writing and spelling. We will begin to read with more fluency.

As Mathematicians, we will be focusing on place value and addition/subtraction within 10 before moving on to exploring shape, both 2D and 3D. We will be practising number formation and using a range of mathematical resources to support our learning including tens frames, part-part-wholes, number tracks and lots more.

As Scientists we will be begin exploring seasons focusing on Autumn through the use of the text Tree: Seasons Come, Seasons Go by Patricia Hegarty & Britta Teckentrup. We will go for a walk to find signs of Autumn and investigate how the environment is changing. Later we will be moving on to our topic of materials where we will find out about lots of different materials and their properties.

As Historians we will be exploring and finding out about the history of Ludlow and the De Lacy family who built and lived in the castle, before the Mortimer family arrived.

As Geographers we will be zooming out of our town, Ludlow and finding out about our County, the United Kingdom. We will be learning about the 4 countries, England, N. Ireland, Scotland and Wales and their capital Cities. We will also discover the oceans that surround the UK and spot famous landmarks and environments such as mountains and Big Ben!

As Artists we will look at light and dark colours and create our own picture inspired by Van Gogh. We will study Artists such as Arcimboldo, Claris Cliff, Carl Warner and Jason Mecier to find out how artists use food as inspiration and resources within their work We will create our own artwork using food as well as still life paintings of food.

<u>As Design Technologists</u> we will be finding out what a portable snack is, why we make portable snacks and how we transport portable snacks. Our final product will be a portable snack for a Christmas movie afternoon. We will explore different skills including cutting, spreading, grating, folding, using a knife and fork and peeling.

As Musicians we will discover the beat within a song and be able to explore pulse and rhythm.

<u>In P.E.</u>, we will be exploring a range of multi skills, including jumping, balancing, listening, teamwork, hand-eye co-ordination and teamwork. Alongside out multi-skills lessons, we will be following the real PE scheme where we focus specifically on one skill.

<u>In Computing</u>, our focus will be 'Online Safety' and 'Grouping & Sorting'. We will be using the purple mash programme for our computing lessons.

<u>In PHSE</u> we will be exploring 'Being Me in My World' and 'Celebrating Difference'. Our PSHE lessons are a time for us reflect on ourselves, our feelings and emotions and day to day life.

<u>In RE</u> we will be looking at What do Christians believe about God and What gifts might Christians in my town have given Jesus.
