



As Writers, we will develop our writing through Talk for Writing, building upon our skills in grammar and punctuation. We will use our phonics knowledge to help us when spelling and we will continue to focus on letter formation and handwriting size. We will use The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch to help us write a defeat the monster tale and a seagull's diary.

As Readers, we will continue to develop our phonic knowledge in daily sessions. We will focus on reading with fluency and expression and answering questions on what we have read. We will continue to read The Hodgeheg as a whole class novel and begin to use our ERIC approach (Everyone reads in Class) to help us understand the book. We will continue to use Cracking Comprehension to develop our comprehension skills.

As Mathematicians, we will study money, multiplication and division, length and height and find out about mass capacity and temperature.

As Scientists, we will continue to study living things and their habitats including how we can work out what's alive and what is not and investigate habitats and food chains. **We will read Home: Where our story begins by Patricia Hegarty.** We will then move onto look at animals including humans. We will also be looking at Forces and Earth and Space.

As Geographers, we will learn how to read maps, use a four point compass and grid references. We will look at key human and physical features of Ludlow and its surrounding areas. **We will read Paddington's Post by Michael Bond & R.W. Alley.**

As Historians, we will study the lives of significant explorers from the past and learn how their discoveries impacted the world we live in today. **We will read The Human Race: A History of Record Breakers by Sean Callery & Donough O'Malley.**

As Designers, we will learn about food hygiene and safety, linking this to the DT cycle; investigating, designing and evaluating.

As Musicians, we will be exploring Musical Moods And Pictures using SparkYard.

In P.E., we will develop our skills needed for invasion games, develop our gymnastic skills and follow our Real PE programme.

In Computing, we will explore Robot Algorithms and Pictograms using Scratch.

In R.E., we will use the Jigsaw programme to explore how important the Qur'an is to Muslims before exploring how important it is to Christians that Jesus came back to life after his crucifixion.

In PHSE, we will use the Jigsaw programme to explore our dreams and goals and learn how to be healthy.
