


I have uploaded questions about the story onto the school website. You can print this off, discuss the answers with a parent or write the answers in your blue books.

Weekly Maths - Measuring Time (break it up over the week)

Money, Money!

In year 1 we begin to look at money by firstly learning the value of our coins and notes.

This week spend time looking at coins and learning their names e.g. 5 pence, 50 pence etc.

- Get coins out and look at them. Sort coins into piles of the same.
- Play a matching game matching coins to the values written down
- Order coins from 1p to £2
- Learn the names of the notes.

Do not worry if you need to spend all week learning to recognise and name the coins... this can be tricky! However, Ii your child quickly understands and learns the names of the coins then you can move on to the following .

- Discuss that the size of the coin doesn't mean it is worth more.
- Take a 2p 5p and 10p. Explain that the value of these coins is 2 one pence pieces, 5 one pence pieces and 10 one pence pieces.
- Look at ways of making 2p, 5p and 10p you could set up a simple shop game. (do not go higher than 10p for now)



Time Capsule Project


Mrs Grant has asked us to set you a very special challenge.


