What could we do to improve it?

Seven Ways to Super Sentences!

- 1) CHANGE WORDS e.g The boy skipped down the road.
- 2) ADD WORDS e.g. The boy skipped merrily down the road.
- 3) ADD A FRONTED ADVERBIAL (I.S.P.A.C.E) e.g Because he was so happy, the boy skipped merrily down the road.

4) ADD ON THE END e.g. The boy skipped merrily down the road because he'd just beaten his friend at football.

5) ADD A RELATIVE CLAUSE (in the middle) e.g. The boy, who had just beaten his friend at football, skipped merrily down the road.

6) ADD A SIMILE OR METAPHOR e.g. The boy skipped merrily down the road and he sang like a bird, as loud as he could.

7) ADD SHOW NOT TELL e.g. A huge smile crept across the boy's face as he skipped merrily down the road.

The leaves blew across the floor.

The leopard stalked its prey.

The girl held her brother's hand.
