Exceptions: There are some words which are exceptions such as deceive and ceiling.

Also, when pronounced 'ay' as in neighbour or weigh.

babys

babys babies

When we make a word ending in s plural, we change the y for an i before adding es.

Exception: if the y comes after a vowel, we simply add s e.g. toys


incredable

incredable incredible

We use 'able 'when there is an obvious root word, such as comfortable; we use 'ible' when there is no obvious root word, such as possible.

Exception: In the case of sensible, the complete root word can be heard before the –ible ending.

leafs



When we make a word ending in f plural, we change the f for v before adding es.

The boys really liked there new football.



There are lots more spelling rules out there too!
