National Curriculum

As Writers, we will be writing a finding tale using character and setting description with ideas taken from The Owl who is afraid of the dark. Our poetry is based on rhyming pairs. We will be writing a recount of our trip to Ludlow Castle and writing about an aboriginal tale, Tiddik The Frog.

As Readers we will continue to develop our phonic knowledge in daily sessions. We will focus on reading with fluency and expression and answering question. We will read Fantastic Mr Fox in ERIC.

As Mathematicians, we will study fractions and time. We will also collect statistical data linked to our science investigations and study position and direction. We will also consolidate our maths learning so far.

As Scientists, we will study plants, Evolution and Inheritance, Electricity and recap other areas of science studied so far. **Focus text: Sam Plants a Sunflower.**

As Historians, we will look at castles—their features and the jobs of those who lived and worked in them. We will also make links with the Mortimer Project and visit Ludlow Castle. **Focus text: Castles.**

As Geographers, we will study Australia and understand the human and physical features of the country.

As Artists, we will look at the work of Hokusai and seascapes from other historical eras. Using this knowledge, we shall use collage to create a seascape of our own.

As Designers, we will explore and create solid structures using a variety of methods to join materials together.

As Musicians, we will explore patterns with pitch, linking pitch and melody, using SparkYard.

In P.E, we will develop our gym following our Real Gym programme. We will also have an athletics unit. We will also compete in our Sports Day.

In Computing, we will experiment with making music and programming quizzes using Scratch.

In R.E, we will explore if it is possible to be kind to everybody all of the time before exploring a Muslim's pilgrimage.

In PSHE, we will use the Jigsaw programme to explore relationships.
