As Writers, we will write on informal letter home as an evacuee during WWII and various short burst writes. We will explore the features of non-chronological reports.

As Readers, we will study the book Kensuke's Kingdom, and use of ERIC sessions to analyse the text and develop our understanding. We will also discuss and analyse a variety of non-fiction texts to identify features and meaning.

As Mathematicians, we will develop our understanding of shape and geometry, position and direction. We will also use the White Rose Planning and NRICH to build on our problem solving and reasoning skills.

As Scientists, we will continue to study and explore evolution. Then we will study Living things and their Habitats.

As Geographers, we will study the biomes of North America.

As Historians, we will study Ancient Greece

In computing, we will be studying 3D modelling and Sensing Movement.

As Musicians, we will use SparkYard to celebrate songs and recap learning.

As Artists, we will be exploring and creating Futurism painting and studying conflict sketches by Henry Moore.

In DT, we will design and build buildings which are able to withstand a flood.

In P.E, we will develop our gym and our multi-skills following our Real PE and Real gym PE programmes. We will also participate in striking and fielding games to practise our skills.

In RE, we will be exploring the questions: *Why are there Gospels and how are they relevant for Christians? And Does belief in Akhirah (life after death) help Muslims lead a good life?*
