As Mathematicians, we will continue to develop our knowledge of decimals, money, time, shape and statistics. We will also be completing our Year 4 Times table Check in June.

As Scientists we will study living things and their habitats and will also recap our knowledge of plants from year 3.

As Historians we will be finding out about our local area history, looking at the Normans.

As Geographers will be exploring maps and carrying out field work of our local area.

As Design Technologists, we will use computer aided designs to create a template for a 3D product.

As artists, we will explore creating drawing buildings to create different cityscapes.
