As Readers We will continue to read Varjak Paw by SF Said.

As Mathematicians, We will learn about statistics, properties of shape; position and direction; converting units, measuring volume and decimals.

<u>As Scientists</u> we will study Animals including humans, particularly focusing on lifecycles. Our second topic is living things and their habitats.

<u>As Historians</u> we will compare and contrast the lives of rich and poor throughout history from the Stone Age to the 17th Century.

As Geographers we will study the different biomes found in the world.

As designers we will explore cam mechanisms in order to create a range of movements. Finally, we will use our skills as designers to create a moving toy.

<u>As artists</u> our theme is The Power of Love and we will focus on 'The Kiss' by Gustav Klimt.

<u>As Musicians</u>, we will explore song ingredients looking at melody, harmony and lyrics.
