<u>As Writers</u>, Use Talk for Writing to write a warning tale (The Caravan). Read T.S Eliot poetry and perform The Highwayman poem.

<u>As Readers</u> we will continue to read Harry Potter and the Chamber of Secrets followed by *Varjak Paw* by SF Said.

<u>As Mathematicians</u>, We will learn about statistics, properties of shape; position and direction; converting units and measuring volume.

<u>As Scientists</u> we will study living things and their habitats, particularly focusing on lifecycles. Our second topic is Animals including humans.

As Historians we will compare and contrast the lives of rich and poor throughout history from the Stone Age to the 17th Century.

As Geographers we will study the different biomes found in the world.

<u>As designers</u> we will explore cam mechanisms in order to create a range of movements. Finally, we will use our skills as designers to create a moving toy.

<u>As artists</u> our theme is The Power of Love and we will focus on 'The Kiss' by Gustav Klimt.

<u>As Musicians</u>, we will learn At the Movies: music from movies from 1920–present day & Celebration: songs for different occasions.
