National Curriculum

As Writers, we will study poetry based on the seaside and we will write our own poem based on it. We will develop fiction writing skills using finding tales based on our Talk for Writing story 'Adventure at Sandy Cove'. We will also develop our non-fiction writing skills by writing a letter to the Year 2 children to inform them what to expect in year 3 due to being a split site school. We will use our spelling and grammar knowledge from our daily RWI spelling lessons to help us and we will continue to focus on letter formation and handwriting size.

As Readers, we will continue to use the Accelerated Reader scheme. We will focus on reading with fluency and expression and answering questions on what we have read. We will read The Sheep Pig by Dick King-Smith as a whole class novel using the ERIC approach (Everyone reads in Class) to help us understand the book. We will continue to use Cracking Comprehension to develop our comprehension skills.

As Mathematicians, we will follow the National Curriculum to understand time; angles; fractions and the properties of 2D as well as 3D shapes.

<u>As Scientists</u>, we will study light and explore and investigate what plants need to grow as well as the reproductive life cycle of a plant.

As Historians, we will study crimes and punishment throughout time.

<u>As Geographers</u> we will be learning about how we are citizens of the world. Children will be looking at the prime meridian, Tropics of Cancer and Capricorn and the poles in more detail.

<u>As Designers</u>, we will experiment with the Makey Makey kit which enables us to control computers using every day objects.

<u>As Musicians</u>, we will continue to follow the music express programme, looking at the human body, food and ancient worlds.

<u>In P.E.</u>, we will develop our cricket skills, athletics ability and improve our personal bests using the REAL PE programme.

In Computing, we will use Purple Mash to explore touch typing.

<u>In R.E.</u> We will explore how and why people try to make the world a better place and study what kind of world Jesus wanted.

<u>In PHSE</u>, we will use the Jigsaw programme and explore relationships and Changing Me.

<u>In Spanish</u>, we will use the Language Angels programme focusing on fruit and vegetables and animals.

<u>Trips and Visitors</u>: we will have the Shropshire Hills Discovery Centre in to teach us about orienteering. The children will also have Stepping Out into school.
